Recidivism Rate - 1st Quarter
There were a total of 115 incidents of where detainees were placed on Investigative Segregation during the 1st Quarter.
Of these 115 incidents, a total of 87 detainees were placed on Investigative Segregation.
Of these 87 detainees, a total of 62 detainees were involved in a single incident (71.26%)
Of these 87 detainees, 22 detainees were involved in two incidents (25.29%)
Of these 87 detainees, 3 detainees were involved in three incidents (3.45%)
