Wyatt Detention with the support of several agencies have embarked on a service to provide Legal Professionals and the Detainee population the ability to conduct Legal Visits through a Video Visitation Program referred to as Jurislink.

This service provides detainees and their Legal Representative(s) the ability to communicate in real time video visits. The service also provides the ability to be share, view and even sign documents through this program, which saves time on traveling to the facility to have documents completed by an Attorney or a Legal Representative. ***All Video Conferences are Confidential as they operate on separate platform than the facility.***

The tentative start date for this service is February 24, 2021. The following guidelines will apply when using this service:

- At this time, Legal Professionals are to follow the preset schedule when reserving sessions; the schedule is available at the following link: <http://www.wyattdetention.com/Visitation/Visiting-Hours>. Legal Professionals can verify detainee housing unit assignments by calling the facility at 401.729.1190. Sessions can be scheduled by visiting www.jurislink.com.
- Sessions scheduled outside of the assigned time frame for a housing unit will be cancelled. Legal professionals will have to re-schedule the appointment at their convenience. Scheduling Legal Professionals will be notified by email stating the reason for a cancellation.
- ***In the beginning, sessions will be held in the Contact Visitation Area which has 6 stations. As more stations become available, the schedule may change allowing more detainees to use the service throughout the building at the same time. The facility will continue to attempt to facilitate some Zoom calls until all 16 Jursilink units are up and running.***
- Facility staff members are unable to schedule JurisLink sessions, as this is done through the JurisLink website and must be completed by the Attorney. Sessions will NOT be scheduled by detainee request through the kiosk, your client will need to contact you to request a session.
- Detainees refusing to attend scheduled sessions, will need to sign a refusal form. This document will then be forwarded to the scheduling Legal Professional.
- JurisLink has preset time frames. Calls will automatically disconnect at the end of each session and detainees will not be allowed to make another call without it being previously scheduled. It is important to communicate with your client the need to stay on task so you can get the most out of your call.



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- Please note that Wyatt is not responsible for dropped calls should they occur, as there is no way to verify on whose end the issue may have been. If the call drops within the scheduled meeting time frame, the Legal Representative/Attorney certainly can try to re-start the call again.
- Detainees who choose to end the call prior to its time, will also not be allowed to get another call until such time one is re-schedule by the Legal Representative/Attorney.
