There were a total of 295 incidents where detainees were placed on Administrative Status during all four quarter as of 2025.

Of these 295 incidents, a total of 222 detainees were placed on Administrative Status

Of these 222 detainees, a total of 178 detainees were involved in a single incident (80.2%)

Of these 222 detainees, 27 detainees were involved in two incidents (12.2%)

Of these 222 detainees, 10 detainees were involved in three incidents (4.5%)

Of these 222 detainees, 3 detainees were involved in four incidents (1.3%)

Of these 222 detainees, 3 detainee were involved in five incidents (1.3%)
